CURE OUTREACH COMMITTEE

We were dismayed to learn in July that a Covid-19 outbreak at Nassawadox Rehabilitation and Nursing closed the facility to outsiders temporarily. Our plans to offer a simple worship service to residents has been deferred for the time being. The gift items that church members contributed were packaged up in Christmas-y fashion and delivered to the facility, in keeping with the “Christmas in July” theme. Every single resident could receive a gift bag, and gifts were also prepared for all staff members. We hoped these would offer a little cheer and moral support during isolation. DOS SANTOS GRANT

The Orr Smith Foundation has awarded Dos Santos \$25,000 for the purchase of a refrigerated van. Dos Santos serves the immigrant and farm worker communities in Accomack and Northampton counties on the Eastern Shore through their Food Pantry and the Thrift Store at Four Corner Plaza in Onley. They serve about 100 families per week, and a refrigerated van will enhance their ability to distribute food at the sites.

Specialized training is required for Clergy, Vestry members, Treasurers, church employees, Eucharistic Visitors, and Pastoral Care Visitors. This training dives deep into specifics related to sexual misconduct, boundaries, inclusion, power, pastoral relationships, and sexual harassment and addresses basic best practices for program supervision.
