What's all the Blue Tape?

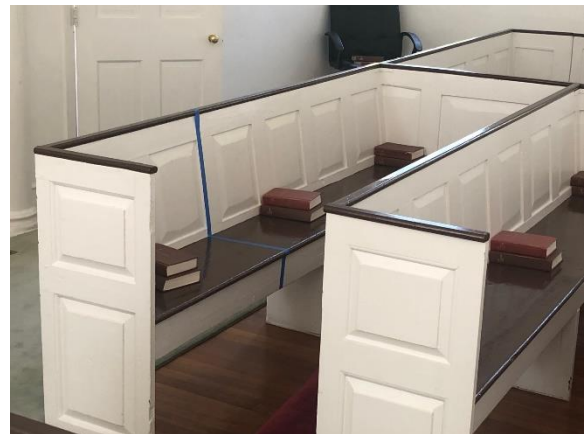
It is time to open the gates of the church wider and make room in both churches for comfortable, accessible seating in church for people in wheelchairs.


I met with the architect who helped Hungars renovate the organ loft when the new organ was installed. He, his brother, a career woodcraftsman and Croxton and I explored every angle of the nave (the area of seating in a sanctuary) for the best place for two wheelchairs.

I was happy to discover the combined talent agreed that removing a few inches off the back two pews (as marked by the blue tape) on the center aisle. This solution will continue to provide visual symmetry and beauty while making it slick and convenient for two wheelchairs to go up the ramp and up the lift to settle comfortably in the church.

The original panels you are used to seeing on the end of the pews will be attached to the pews where now the blue tape is.

Hungars Vestry has approved the upgrade to our worship space and the work will begin soon. We welcome your comments.
